Thanks for booking on to one of our learning experiences, we know you are going to find it a great experience and we really look forward to seeing you!

Our booking terms:

We don't want to make things complicated but, we do believe that it's important that everyone has the same understanding when booking onto the training opportunities we run.

With this in mind we have a few simple terms and conditions for booking and participating in our training.

1. Places on our learning experiences are offered on a first come first served bases.
2. Only registered adult members of UK Scouting (with DBS vetting if attending a residential course), will be able to book onto our training.
3. We use Jotform (jotform.com) to administer our bookings.
 - Jotform is the only way you can book a place on any of our learning opportunities
 - Where applicable, catering fees are automatically added to bookings and are payable at the time of booking
 - Jotform will send you an automated booking confirmation when a booking is made
4. As you will appreciate, our training is planned and delivered by our volunteer training team. A lot of time goes into planning our learning opportunities to make them happen. Please only book onto this module if you absolutely intend to block the time out of your schedule and honour your commitment to attend.

We know things can happen, so if you find you are really unable to attend this session, please let us know, by emailing training@southlondonscouts.org.uk, as soon as you can, and at least 24 hours before.

We continue to monitor this situation. If people continue to not attend the training they have booked onto we will, regrettably, have to introduce a small universal booking fee for future published learning opportunities to drive commitment.

5. Our training sessions are interactive and will involve discussions and sometimes involve groups where you can talk and discuss with others.
6. For your safety and the safety of the others taking part and to enable you to fully engage with our training your camera must stay on throughout our zoom sessions. Failure to have your camera on will mean that your participation in the training will not be recorded on your personal learning plan – after all you wouldn't sit with a cardboard box over your head if we were all together in a hall!
7. Joining instructions will be sent out by email during the week before the planned training.
